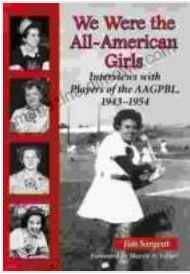

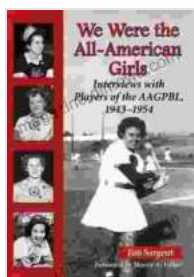
In 1954, the AAGPBL folded, but the legacy of these women lives on. They paved the way for women's sports, and they showed the world that women

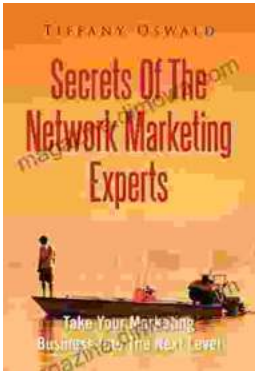
